Commencement

This correction sheet for the institutional part of the curriculum comes into effect on 15 August 2018 and applies to all students who are admitted to the programme on the stated date, or later.

Changes to Institutional Part of the curriculum

1. The subject element Company relationships / Commerce:

The subject element in the English curriculum is now called **Commerce** – and **NOT Company relationships** – this applies to the subject element and the exam, as well as in all tables and overviews etc. regarding the programme.

2. The subject element Production and quality management / Production and quality control

The subject element in the English curriculum is now called **Production and quality control** – and **NOT Production and quality management** – this applies to the subject element and the exam, as well as in all tables and overviews etc. regarding the programme.

3. The subject element Statistical experimental planning / Statistical experimental design

The subject element in the English curriculum is now called **Statistical experimental design** – and **NOT Statistical experimental planning** – this applies to the subject element and the exam, as well as in all tables and overviews etc. regarding the programme.

4. Pertaining to section 3.7. Commerce (previously Company relationships) – 1st semester – 5 ECTS - description of exam

Original formulation:

Exam form and organisation

The exam is an individual written case report (scope 9-11 standard pages) and an oral presentation and examination. Preparation time 3 days/72 hours. The duration of the oral examination is 25 minutes, divided according to: presentation 5-10 min, exam 10-15 min and discussion of marks 5 min.

Prerequisites to take the exam

In order to take the oral part of the exam, the case report must be handed-in and the obligation to participate in classes must be met as described in section 13.

Assessment criteria

The basis of assessment is the oral presentation as well as the exam, the case report is the basis of the exam. The exam is assessed as a whole according to the 7-point scale and has an internal co-examiner.

Changed to:

Exam form and organisation

The exam is an individual oral examination on the basis of a report prepared in groups (2 to 3 students), with a maximum of 5 standard pages/student.

The duration of the oral examination is 25 minutes, divided according to: presentation 5-10 min, exam 10-15 min and discussion of marks 5 min.

Prerequisites to take the exam

In order to take the oral part of the exam, the report must be handed-in and the obligation to participate in classes must be met as described in section 13.

Assessment criteria

The basis of assessment is the individual oral presentation and as well as the exam. The exam is assessed as a whole according to the 7-point scale and has an internal co-examiner.
